

MOTHERLAND – SURVEY RESULTS

Information for participants in the survey

In the letter you received, you were told that you could find a map where the matches close to your sample originate. You can find these by clicking on the links below. In some cases, your map may be of a very specific area, and so it may not immediately be obvious what area or country it shows.

If you look at the bottom of the screen, you will see a precise longitude and latitude.

If you put these figures into a web search engine ([click here](#), for example) you will be able to get a more general map which names the exact location.

A "N" i.e. North is a positive number, and is therefore entered normally, but a "S" i.e. South is a negative number so you need to put a minus sign in front of it.

Similarly, an East is a positive number, but a West is a negative number.

e.g. N12.27 E9.31 would be entered "12.27, 9.31"
but S 25.97 E32.58 would be entered "-25.97, 32.58"
